

Application to drive a motor vehicle to or from school



STUDENT USE OF MOTOR VEHICLE

The driving of motor vehicles by students to and from school sites is controlled by the school. This is to ensure appropriate standards of safety for all students (drivers, passengers, cyclists and pedestrians) and the controlled use of the school's limited car parking facilities.

Accordingly, students may drive motor vehicles to and from school sites if the driver holds a current provisional (4 point) Queensland Drivers Licence or a current Open (12 point) Queensland Drivers Licence, and has obtained the written permission of the Principal.

Students wishing to carry passengers must have the written approval of both sets of parents.

Where a student breaches the school's policy, either as driver or passenger, the Principal may impose consequences including the loss of privileges or suspension from school for disobedience.

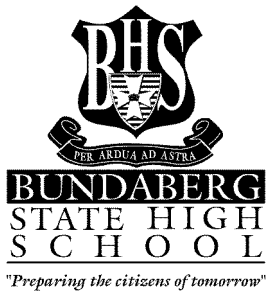

TERMS & CONDITIONS

The approval by the school for the student named on this application to drive the specified motor vehicles as listed on this application to and/or from school is conditional on;

1. The school does not accept responsibility for any traffic violation, accident, injury or damage to person or property which may occur as a result of student usage (authorised or otherwise) of a motor vehicle.
2. The driver and the motor vehicle shall comply with all licencing, registration and compulsory insurance requirements.
3. The motor vehicle shall be parked legally in recognised parking areas.
4. The student may not go to the motor vehicle during the school day without the permission of a member of the teaching staff.
5. The student may use the motor vehicle to travel to and/or from a school event at another location ONLY if the school has not provided transport to and from that location. If school transportation is available (eg. a bus), the students must use the bus (exceptions may apply where approval has been given for a student to go directly home after an event within Bundaberg)
6. While travelling to and/or from the school, the motor vehicle may carry passengers, but only those students which have been approved by the school (ie. Siblings of the driver and students travelling with prior written parent approval). Students wishing to carry passengers **MUST** have the written approval of both sets of parents prior to the transportation of passengers.
7. Consequences for failure to abide by these terms and conditions may be imposed by the school as is required.
