SUBJECT OUTLINE: There are few more satisfying feelings than to have created something. Students, selecting to complete this modified Year 10 Creative Art course, will participate in an exciting, hands-on selection from the Arts. They will investigate a rich and colourful diversity of units from media and visual art.
