Criteria	Explanation
Academic Achievement	Your application must include a copy of your last three reports signed by the principal of your school.
Conduct	Conduct in the classroom, playground and school activities must be excellent at all times. You must include the contact details (email) of two referees from your current school e.g. class teacher, principal.
Leadership	Please provide a summary of achievement and commitment in all activities, curricular and non-curricular that demonstrates that you are a role model to your peers. This could include examples such as: captain of school, sport team captain, class captain, participation in school and community activities such as: school sport, concert band or orchestra, school musical etc.
Confirmation by your Parents and Principal	This application must be approved (counter-signed) by your parents/guardian and the principal at your school and include referee contact information (email and contact number) e.g. Classroom Teacher, Principal, Previous Teacher.

Documentary evidence

All applications must include documentary evidence. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that appropriate documentation is provided. Documents, resumes and other attachments must be photocopies and attached to the application (originals will not be returned).
